Day Two:

<u>Chemical Additives in the Wet End:</u> Chemicals to enhance produce quality / Chemicals for runnability improvement / Introduction into fibre & wet end chemistry

<u>Forming Section:</u> Single & multi-layer designs / Sheet forming fundamentals / Dewatering elements & vacuum system / Retention / Impact on product quality & runnability / Fabric considerations

Day Three:

<u>The Press Section:</u> Press section designs / Fundamentals of pressing / Press nips: grooved, blind drilled, shoe press / Press section impact on product quality & runnability / Press felts & conditioning

<u>The Dryer Section:</u> Fundamental of paper & board drying / Build up of dryer groups / Drying cylinder / Steam & condensate Systems / Pocket ventilation / Dew point & 0-level / Dryer section operations / The Dryer fabric & cleaning

Day Four:

Finishing & Reel Up Systems: Online-calendaring fundamentals / Reel Up Systems

<u>Introduction to Process Control:</u> Computer aided process simulation / "From mixing chest to reel-up" / Start-up of the paper machine / Working with closed control loops / Adjust various machine parameters to improve product quality
