The UK has a long-established line of Paper Industry organisations, which started in 1872 with the The Paper Makers' Association of England Wales, Scotland & Ireland (PMA). The PMA announced the intention to form a Technical Section at their AGM in 1920. The following year, this was inaugurated and the Technical Section of the Paper Makers' Association of England, Wales, Scotland and Ireland commenced work. The Technical Section transformed into the Technical Division, before it became the Technical Association in 1982. **So 2020 marked the centenary of PITA**.

#### **Publications**


Since 1960, Paper Technology has been the official journal of the Technical Section / Division / Association.
