What are we looking for?

- Ideally a minimum HNC in Chemistry or similar science discipline and/or a minimum of 3 years relevant work experience
- Strong initiative, an ability to analyse technical problems, and to use a range of influencing skills to make required improvements and efficiencies

Main responsibilities:

1. Safe and efficient use of process chemicals on site
2. Trial work with chemicals in both the lab and on the paper machines
3. Ensure MSDS and COSHH assessments are maintained for all chemicals on site
4. Technical support to the production process in the areas of Wet End Chemistry & Coating Chemicals
5. Technical support in the areas of process monitoring & process development
6. Assist in areas of Product Safety
7. Technical advice on the day to day operation of the effluent treatment plant to ensure efficient performance and permit conditions are met
8. Implement the requirements of the mill Environmental (EPR) Permit and ensure ongoing compliance
